Robinson, established a Revocable Trust of which one of its purposes is to grow Glenaire’s Micou Browne Endowment, which provides resident financial assistance.

Born on June 5, 1926, Dick grew up in Irwin, Pennsylvania. After graduating High School, during WWII, Dick served in the United States Army Air Corp beginning as a radio operator, and rising to rank of 2nd Lieutenant. He later attended The University of Pittsburgh, and earned a degree in Electrical Engineering. Dick put his degree to use at Penn Electric, but saw an opportunity in reinforced plastic molding and in 1969, founded Penn Compression Moulding, Inc. The company, now known as Penn, continues to prosper and boasts two manufacturing facilities with over 100 employees.

Dick was married to Irene Francis King for 62 years and the couple had three daughters. Dick and Irene enjoyed traveling and took the opportunity to see the world. In their later years, the couple were residents of Glenaire.

Glenaire held a special place in Dick’s heart, having served on the committee that brought Glenaire into existence. Placing Glenaire in his Trust was a meaningful way for Dick to sustain the future for residents of the community he worked so diligently to help build.
